

STARPOINT HIGH SCHOOL PARKING GUIDELINES

- Cars must have a valid Starpoint High School parking permit hung from the rear-view mirror. The license plate number should be clearly visible.
- Permits are valid for the current school year only, these permits are not transferable at any time.
- There is to be no smoking, loitering, horseplay, or misconduct in or around vehicles. Students should exit their vehicle upon arriving and head directly into the building.
- Drivers are not to pass any school bus while it is being loaded or while it is proceeding into or out of the parking lot.
- Students are not permitted to go to their cars during the day without first receiving permission from an administrator or office staff.
- Drivers who violate any of the above regulations or endanger themselves or others will lose their permit and could face severe disciplinary action, including permanent revocation of parking privileges.

Students who are chronically tardy to school will face disciplinary action, as follows:

Late 4 – 6 times will serve a lunch detention

Late 7 – 9 times will serve after school detention

Late 10 times - parking pass will be revoked or in-school suspension will be assigned.

Parking privileges can be revoked if the student does not adhere to the District Code of Conduct.

PLEASE REMEMBER – The primary interest of the school is the safety of our students and staff. Student drivers and their passengers are responsible for their conduct in the parking lot and area near the school. Please act responsibly for your safety and that of others.

Parking Guidelines/Permit

Students do have the opportunity to drive to school during their junior and senior years, and this is a privilege that many of our upperclassmen take advantage of. If your son or daughter wishes to drive to school this year, please have him or her fill out the parking permit application (see attached "Parking Guidelines").

Two items need to be completed for a parking permit to be issued:

- 1. The attached "Parking Guidelines" form must be signed and submitted to the secretary in the High School Office before a parking permit can be issued.***
- 2. The Parking Permit Registration form must be completed and submitted electronically. Please click the link below to access the required form.***

By driving to school, students are taking additional risks inherent with driving. In addition to the safety issues of driving on snowy roads and in a crowded parking lot, Starpoint High School does have a strict attendance policy in place. Chronic tardiness caused by driving might result in the revocation of driving privileges.
