Dear #OneStarpoint Athletes and Families:

The Section VI Executive Committee met on Monday, February 22, 2021 and voted to allow home schools the option of allowing up to two (2) spectators per HOME athlete for the remainder of the winter season. Visiting teams are not allowed to have spectators at away contests. The only exception is for Boys and Girls Ice Hockey. The new policy goes into effect on Wednesday, February 24, 2021.

In the sports of basketball and swimming, the host districts will have the prerogative to allow up to two home spectators per athlete. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate fans for home Boys Swimming contests. We do not have the room in the stands as this is where we have the athletes stay until they have to swim in their events. We will continue to live stream our home Boys Swimming contests.

We will be able to accommodate two home fans per athlete for all levels of boys and girls basketball. This is the maximum number of spectators that will be allowed per athlete, and we will strictly adhere to this policy.

Since hockey and bowling are held at private businesses, the prevailing parameters at each facility will be followed. For instance, the majority of hockey facilities allow only one spectator per athlete. Please keep in mind that we do not have the authority to override the protocols of private facilities. We are guests of these facilities and their standards/protocols will apply.

At this time, spectators will not be allowed at Manor Lanes II. We will continue to live stream our home bowling contests.
