

Raptor V-Soft Visitor Management System



The district installed a Visitor Management System in April 2012. (*Raptor V-Soft Visitor Management System*). The reason for this system is to improve the security and protection of our faculty, staff, and students.

With this system, **we will require anyone who is visiting &/or volunteering in our school to provide their license.** Your license will be scanned into the Raptor System and compared with information from a sex offender database. The only information that is read by the Raptor system is your name, date of birth, and your photo. No other information is accessed by scanning your license.

Anyone who plans to visit &/or volunteer in our building must wear a badge that is printed out by the office staff after your license is scanned. If you have already had your license scanned in our office, simply give us your last name and we will confirm that you are in our system. Once your name and photo appear on our screen, we will print you out your badge. ***Please be prepared to bring your license whether it's been scanned or not just in case there is a glitch in the system.***

Our faculty and staff have been informed to stop anyone they see not wearing a badge and have them return to the office. We ask that once your visit is complete, simply return your printed badge and the office staff will sign you out.

Please remember, this is for the safety and protection of your children. We ask that you cooperate with the new rules implemented by the District and remember to bring your license with you upon each visit.
