The polls were opened at 7:00 a.m. by Timothy Dray, Chairperson.

Voting continued until 8:00 p.m. at which time the polls were closed by Timothy Dray, Chairperson.

Under the direction of the Chief Election Inspector, Mrs. Debra Kroening, the votes were tallied.

The Chief Election Inspector announced the results of the voting as follows:

Proposition #1 – 2022-23 Budget: Shall the general fund budget totaling \$61,628,853 as adopted by the Board of Education for the school year 2022-23, be approved and the required funds be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of the school district, to be levied as required by law?

Yes – 755

No – 304

Budget passed.

School Board Member Election: Elections were for three members of the Board of Education. Two seats each for 3-year terms for the two highest vote getters and one 2-year term for the third highest vote getter.

Voting Results:

Two 3-Year Term Winners:

Beth Pyskaty - 707

One 2-Year Term Winner:

Chad Shepherd – 659

Not Elected:

Aric Brocious – 539

Mr. Zimmerman and Mrs. Pyskaty were each elected to 3-year terms and Mr. Shepherd was elected to two-year term. All terms begin July 1, 2022.
