On this page, I will have various activities on a “Tic-Tac-Toe Board” for you to choose from and I will put up a link to my Youtube Channel. A new video will be posted for a sing/play along every Monday.

If you **do not** have **internet** access at home or have limited access to a computer, follow these instructions (using either the radio or CD or if you have music on your phone) and choose songs you know and love. Pick 2-3 options below each week. Remember you are welcome to perform the same activities each week but choose a new song!

1. Have a dance party to a fun upbeat song.
2. Teach the refrain (the part that comes back to repeat over and over again) to a song you love and think your child should know!
3. Pick an instrumental piece of music (no words) you enjoy and ask your child to respond to these questions:
 - a. Is the Music Fast or Slow?
 - b. How does the music make you feel? ie: happy, sad, angry, hopeful etc.
 - c. Do you hear any specific instruments? ie: guitar, violin, drum, trumpet etc.
 - d. If this song were to tell a story what would the story be about and draw a picture to show it.
4. Choose an up beat piece of music and clap or play the beat on a Non-traditional instrument (ie: soup pot, pan, lid, coffee container, etc)
5. Listen to some calming music and make up your own movements to reflect the nature of the music.

If you have Ms. Watson or Mrs. Lawrence for Kindergarten, you will receive music activities from Mrs. Teichman through your child’s classroom teacher. I will be accessing Class Dojo and Email if you have any questions.
