Homework

Supplies

- Paper
- Coloring supplies (I will tell you when to bring them.)
- Text book
- Homework packet

Extra help

- Students can complete corrections and make up two quizzes per quarter during the extra help period in order to improve their grades.

Exam

All students must take a proficiency exam at the end of eighth grade. The proficiency exam counts as one fifth of their final average. Students must pass the course and the exam in order to receive a required credit for high school graduation.
